



PRINCE2® Re-registration

PRINCE2® is an internationally recognised best practice project management methodology. Since its inception in 1989, it has been widely adopted and successfully implemented throughout both the public and private sectors around the world.

The re-registration course allows those who have previously passed their PRINCE2 Practitioner exam to re-register their practitioner status if it is due to expire or has expired.

PRINCE2 Practitioner registration lasts for five years from the date of the last exam pass.

Audience

Course duration

Two days.

Pre-requisites

Delegates must have previously passed the PRINCE2 Practitioner exam. Delegates are expected to spend time before the course reading through the pre-course materials.









Course outline

The course is conducted through interactive group study using practical examples and activities. A significant amount of time is spent looking at the sample exam papers with scenarios provided by the examination board.

Exam details

The re-registration exam lasts for 1 hr. It consists of three questions worth 10 points each and the pass mark is 55%.

Alternatively many delegates elect to take the full practitioner exam (2.5hrs, 8 questions) as this allows a broader spectrum of topics when completing the exam. Both are open book exams.

Course content

Application of PRINCE2:

A variety of exercises using our own case study are used to cover PRINCE2 Practitioner topics

Exam preparation:

Two additional case studies and exams supplied by the examination board are used to re-enforce the PRINCE2 topics and provide exam practice

Evening study:

Delegates are expected to spend time reading and reviewing course as well as completing sample exam questions.
